That would be just impolite and plain rude. In the same way, it's important to interact with those people who visited your blog. Try to ask for feedback or for your visitors to share similar experiences they may have had. When people leave a comment then make sure you take the time to respond.

The last but not least is to use common courtesy. It's necessary to leave something to thank them for coming to your party. But what kind of courtesy do you show to your blog visitors is right? One way is to thank them for leaving a comment. Most comment boxes allow you to personalise some text within the comment box. You can fully thank your readers for taking the time to stop by and leave you a comment. Also you can place a welcome message somewhere on your page thanking people for taking the time to stop by and visit your blog. It is a warm and effective way. Just try it. How you go about extending common courtesy to your blog visitors will vary from person to person. But to do this is so important if you really need support from others.
